## **Killarney Homestead**

***41 Darley Road, Nashdale***

Extensive beds planted with roses, lavenders, pansies, daises, bulbs and many other cottage favorites in gardens established on “no dig” principal surrounding the federation homestead. A Good collection of deciduous trees designed to allow views over surrounding countryside and nearby orchards. 1.21ha (3 ac)

**Directions**—From Orange High School (Cnr Mitchell Highway and Coronation Drive) travel along Coronation Drive which becomes Cargo Road (Orange-Grenfell Road) travel 9km to Nashdale turn left into Darley Road and travel 400m to garden on left. If traveling from the Garden & Lifestyle Expo at Borenore, follow signs to Nashdale on Borenore Road for 9km to intersection with Cargo Road, turn right and directly left into Darley Road. Garden 400m on left.

**Open—20 & 21 March 2010, 9am to 4.30pm Cost \$6**

## **Timbertop**

***957 Cargo Road, Nashdale***

Autumn highlights are a collection of maples and dogwoods in this lovely cool climate garden they are successfully combined with exotic and Australian plants framed by venerable eucalypts. An interesting collection of historical horticulture implements including a horse drawn furnace once used to burn orchard pruning. 1ha (2.46ac)

**Directions**—From Orange High School (Cnr Mitchell Highway and Coronation Drive) travel along Coronation Drive which becomes Cargo Road (Orange-Grenfell Road). Travel through Nashdale to garden on left of Lister Hill (sign at bottom of the hill). If traveling from the Garden & Lifestyle Expo at Borenore, follow signs to Nashdale on Borenore Road for 9km to T intersection with Cargo Road, turn right on Cargo Road and travel 1 km. Garden on left.

**Open—20 & 21 March 2010, 9am to 4.30pm Cost \$6**
